Legislative Committee Update

AISA Legislative Committee Carol Worley, Nathan Culp, Katie Bodenhamer and Karen McKinney

Despite our efforts this year and our thinking that all the stars were aligning for us, our bill was not successful this session.

In the end, we only had 35 votes for the bill. We needed twice that many.

By way of history, when our original bill failed to make it out of committee we refiled HB1955 with compromise language that provided for no less than one-half (rather than 1/3) of the net proceeds go to the claimant. We passed out of Committee with that. However, it failed to pass on the House Floor vote.

We had opposition from the Arkansas Bar Association, the Arkansas Trial Lawyer's Association and a lot of the legislators themselves. Several Representatives got on the House Floor and spoke against the bill with a lot of inaccurate information. Even some legislators who had voted for our bill last session and had voted for our current bill to pass out of committee didn't vote for it on the Floor. We also thought we had an agreement with the AWCC with regard to the bill, but that turned out not to be the case. It came out the night before the vote that they were taking a neutral position regarding the bill and that seemed to send the message that they didn't support it. The ATLA lawyers and ABA testified at the Committee meetings and put out significant inaccurate information that created great confusion as to the purpose of the bill. In short, we didn't succeed in our efforts.

The Board has discontinued our arrangement with the lobbyists and is looking at different ways to approach the legislature next session. We are open to suggestions and ideas on how to go about this. We will keep the membership apprised of our actions and, as always, will continue to represent you through our advocating, planning, education, and legislative efforts. We continue to invite all of our members to become involved and assist in these endeavors.






